It is an honor to have recently accepted the role of Lead Dentist of the Dental Program at the Community Health Center. This is a vibrant and exciting dental program, providing state-of-the-art dental treatment, restoration, and preventive services to all ages – pediatric to senior.

Our four dentists and four dental hygienists work tirelessly to provide affordable and friendly oral health care to all patients.

Last year, we provided over 8,500 dental visits at our three sites, primarily to people with significant dental concerns and few resources.

Unfortunately, our waiting list grows with each passing week, and we struggle to keep up with the demand.

A post-graduate Dental Residency Program is in development at the CHC.

As one pathway to address the growing wait list, we are pleased to announce that the CHC is developing a post-graduate Dental

Residency Program, to draw young dental professionals to our region and increase our workforce. This is just one example of how the Community Health Center continually strategizes to improve community health, from head to toe.
